

## MEMBERSHIP

The following are eligible for membership:

- Retired members of the UCLA Academic Senate
- Retired members of the Librarians Association of the University of California, Los Angeles
- Those with emeritus/emerita status conferred individually by the university
- Emeriti from other UC campuses or universities (with approval by the UCLA EA Board)
- Spouses/partners or surviving spouses/partners of those listed above or of Academic Senate members who have died in service

First-time members receive a one-year complimentary membership. Current dues thereafter are \$25 per year for an individual member or \$35 per year for a member and spouse/partner. Upon reaching age 85, members are eligible for a complimentary honorary membership.

# UCLA Emeriti Association

The UCLA Emeriti Association (UCLA EA) fosters opportunities for continued involvement with the campus, advocates for retired faculty and librarians, and represents emeriti interests. Formed in 1967, it is an all-volunteer membership organization.

The UCLA EA maintains close working relationships with the UCLA Academic Senate, University Club, and Retirees Association (UCLARA). The association represents emeriti at the UC systemwide level as a member of the Council of UC Emeriti Associations (CUCEA), a consortium of emeriti associations from all UC campuses.

Throughout the years, the UCLA EA has contributed to the welfare of emeriti in many ways, including supporting the establishment of the Academic Senate Emeriti Committee on Emeriti Affairs, securing special parking privileges for emeriti, creating emeriti awards, and spurring the creation of CUCEA. The association continues to work vigorously on behalf of UCLA emeriti.

In 1969, the UCLA EA was instrumental in developing the UCLA Emeriti/Retirees Relations Center (ERRC), a campus department that provides the connecting link between UCLA and its retired faculty and staff. The ERRC offers educational programs, assists with obtaining parking and Bruincards, provides resource information and complimentary notary services for retirees, and contributes administrative support to the UCLA EA and UCLARA.
