To the artists among us:

A year ago, devastating fires destroyed both the Palisades and Altadena communities. Most residents lost everything and others whose home still stand had to throw out most furnishings, clothing, and other porous items, including pictures and artifacts which they have collected over the years. Today, they struggle to either resettle or rebuild, knowing that much of what they lost cannot be replaced. Over a thousand UCLA retirees, emeriti, staff and faculty, alumni and students were among the fire survivors.

The UCLA Emeriti Association through its Arts and Crafts Exhibit Committee has extended its activities to establish the Art for Fire Survivor Project, for sharing artwork which you may wish to contribute to the fire survivors to brighten their environment, as they recover and heal from an experience which none of them expected.

If you would like to participate and contribute one or more pieces of your artwork to be given to fire survivors, please complete the attached form, including a photo of the art to be contributed, and return it to jpermaul@saonet.ucla.edu. An electronic catalog will be posted on the Emeriti Association website, from which UCLA affiliated fire survivors can choose a piece or two which they may like to have. The Committee will connect the survivor's request with the respective artist to arrange for the delivery of the artwork, sensitive to privacy and security for all concerned.

The Committee anticipates Art for Fire Survivors to be a multi-year program, effective since the 2025 Sylvia Winstein Art and Crafts Exhibit and hopefully ends in 3-4 years when the need wanes. The entire program is voluntary, providing an opportunity to give and receive from among Bruins.
